

SOUTH EAST OPEN STUDIOS – COVID-19 GUIDELINES

South East Open Studios is committed to helping our members hold a safe 2021 event. For those of you who are planning to visit any of our open studios, here are the COVID-19 guidelines that we are suggesting for our artists and visitors—

We want to ensure that all of our visitors enjoy their experience of open studios as well as feeling safe. We have provided our members with information to ensure they are COVID safe. This includes—

- Rigid adherence to the limited number of people in a house ruling
- Keep a register of visitors for track and trace
- Sanitising hand gel for visitors entering a studio
- Ensuring visitors over eleven years old wear a face mask (unless exempt)
- Ensuring visitors keep two metres apart when in the studio or exhibition space
- Keeping windows/doors open to enhance ventilation, and where possible creating a one-way system
- Reducing touching of surfaces or products and cleaning with disinfectant on a regular basis

We ask any visitors who have any symptoms of coronavirus to stay at home and not visit the artists or open studios. We also ask any artists who display symptoms to close their studio, inform the committee on chair@seos-art.org and to clearly signal closure on the door to their studio.
